

**Credentials Committee  
Plan Proposed Changes – December 2009**

Section	Change
3.1	Authorizes use of the Centralized Credentialing Office for applications and primary source verifications. Eliminates the pre-application process and defines when an application is not required to be processed without a denial of membership or clinical privileges
3.2	Reduces the number of required references while obtaining valid clinical competence information
3.3	Allows for a 30 day notification for initial applications that are not completed to be closed
4.1	Outlines the responsibility of an applicant to update material changes in an application within 10 days and the required process for correcting an application in writing
4.2	Addresses the process for submitting applications and payment to the CCO
4.3 & 7.3	Redefines timeframe for completing application to two weeks prior to Credentials Committee
7.1.E	Eliminates requirement to review participation in staff and department meetings and CPR requirement for reappointment (covered in previous bullet)
8.2	Defines peer references required at reappointment for courtesy (low volume providers) based on current definition
9.7.2	Addresses criteria development process for single specialty clinical privileges vs. multi-specialty
20.1	Adding in LTC definition text deleted in error
24.2 & 24.3F	Removes references to CIDP committee since it is not utilized
25.0	Defines AHP's scope of service and responsibility, minimum qualifications, clinical supervision requirements and clinical privileges in a consistent format, adds specific language for CRNAs and removes specific delineation of privilege references
