

Physician CPOE Now Available Online

TO ATTEND  **Le Bonheur**
Children's Medical Center **oneChart CPOE ON LINE SESSIONS**

We have developed an online program of instruction through CHEX web to meet the required training for **Managing Patient Care Using Computerized Physician Order Entry (CPOE)**.

Methodist Le Bonheur Medical Executive Council (MEC) has now adapted Rules and Regulations to state that CPOE training and competency is a requirement of medical staff prior to a hospital going live with CPOE.

To receive credit for each session you must **pass the test** with 80% or better and fax the completed and signed **Declaration of Attendance** form to 901-387-3441. When you have completed all four sessions in this manner you will be eligible for 8 CME credits.

1. Go to your web browser.
2. Type www.chexweb.com into the url field. You should see a login screen.
3. Enter your log in:
 - Type **"lb"** as in learning better,
 - Type (with no spaces) **your** 6-digit ID (numbers only)
 - Type (with no spaces) **your** final letter (**p**, and **r**). **Do not** include your initials.
 - Type **your password** (your last name in **lower case** letters)

Example: username: lb123456p
password: jones

NOTE: If you have problems logging in please call Pam Thompson at 516-0369 and she will help you from here.

4. Type in **CPOE** and click **Search**.
5. Scroll to the bottom of the list and locate the **Managing Patient Care Using CPOE Session 1: Enhanced View and Orders**
(Notice Session 2 is located right below. When you have completed Session 1 please go back and complete Session 2. Sessions and 3 and 4 appear in this location as well.)
6. Click **Launch**. Please read all of the instructions on the introduction screen.
7. If you are retaking the session due to a failing test score, you must also pass the test with **80% or above** to receive credit.

Remember to turn on your audio on your computer.
