Beginning **March 30, 2021**, Methodist Le Bonheur Healthcare will implement the **21st Century Cures Act**, which mandates that patients are able to see all encounter types and includes **ALL** notes except Psychotherapy notes. Patients will be able to view the clinical documentation you write on the MLH Patient Portal.



On **March 30**, patients will be able to additionally view:

- Procedure, Surgical, and Anesthesia Notes
- Hospital Provider and Nursing Notes
- Behavioral Health Unit: Labs, Diagnostics, Procedures, Progress Notes, Nursing Notes
- Pathology Reports (All)
- MMG Clinical Notes
- Sutherland Cardiology (Additional Clinic Notes)
- Clinical Information Received from other Providers Outside our HealthCare System (Scanned or Electronically Received)
- Images Taken (Wounds, Dermatology, etc.) and Saved to Chart

Patients will not be able to see:

- Psychotherapy Notes
- Notes that would lead to harm events
- Administrative and Billing Information
- Diagnostic Images
